This letter is to notify you that the APWU has withdrawn local grievance #69340-18 regarding a concern that you were denied Light Duty work. After investigating your concerns the union has found there is no contractual obligation for the USPS to provide Light Duty work to Postal Support Employees (PSEs.)

Additionally, the union has also withdrawn local grievance #69802-18 regarding a concern that you lost wages after your OWCP claim was approved. The reason for the withdrawal is the union is not responsible for filing grievances over any lost wages incurred as a result of an approved on the job injury claim.
